#### Weather

I will be spending time outside. I will need good shoes to explore. It may be sunny, cloudy, or rainy. Our group will still spend time outside! If it is too rainy, we might do our activities in the barn.





## Museum manners

I will follow the rules at Historic Forestville. I will stay with my group and only touch things that the tour guide tells me to. When I am exploring Historic Forestville and the park, I will leave everything where it is. If I see flowers, rocks, or sticks, I can look with my eyes.







## If I see a horse...

I might see a horse walking on the path. I will step to the side and let the horse walk past me. I will use a quiet voice, stand still, and keep my hands to myself so the horse feels safe and happy. These rules keep me safe.



### **Museum staff**

The museum staff will be there to help me on my field trip.

They can answer my questions. Museum staff wear green or grey shirts.





## Moving through Historic Forestville

I will move between different buildings at Historic Forestville.

The ground will be uneven in some places. I will travel on gravel, stone, and grass.





# Taking a break

If I need to take a break, that is okay! I can sit on a picnic table with my adult. It is quiet and peaceful there.

I can relax until I am ready to rejoin my group.





## Changes

The museum changes sometimes! It is fun to do new things. If something is closed, it may be open next time! We might not see every room, but we will see lots of cool things!











## Wagon Barn

I will go to the barn and see farm tools. I might use some of the tools! I will not use every tool. The tools might be heavy or sharp. Adults will help me stay safe. We will use the tools outside on the soft grass. The barn is dim, but the sunshine outside helps me see.



## **General Store**

I will visit the general store! It is full of clothing, kitchen tools, and books! Museum staff will tell me which items I can touch. I will go play shopping!

I will look for items on my shopping list with my classmates. We might feel soft clothing or hard, smooth candles. There are lots of cool items in the store to see! I can ask a tour guide if I see something I want to touch.
