Overview

Entering the house

There are restrooms in the basement. I can tell an adult if I need to use the restroom. I will take the stairs or elevator downstairs to get there.



Museum manners

I will follow the rules at the James J. Hill House. I will stay with my group and won't run. I will not have food or drink in the house. It is very important that I don't touch anything at the house; this helps keep old items safe.







Museum staff

The museum staff will be there to help me on my field trip.

They can answer my questions. Museum staff wear name tags or lanyards.



Moving around the house

We will move between many rooms on multiple floors. We can take the stairs with our classmates or use the elevator if we need it. The house is very old and might be dim. Some rooms have soft carpet or rugs, and some have hardwood floors.







Taking a break

If I need to take a break, that is okay! I can tell an adult. A staff member will help me find a quiet space. There is a quiet room on the second floor and an activity room with games on the third floor. I can relax with an adult until I am ready to rejoin my group.

Changes

The museum changes sometimes! It is fun to do new things. If something is closed, it may be open next time!

If I'm on a longer field trip, I might see bedrooms or the school room on the third floor. I also might see the boiler room.

Rooms
